Economic Autonomy and Prevention to Violence for Indigenous Women

Fotzi it's an indigenous women organization created to make better her pour economic and nutritional situation. They initiated working in productive projects like organic and familiar orchards, production of zeta fungi and eroded ground recovery using organic tecnologies.

Fotzi has received three different grants from Semillas to complete their work, including a proposal to give training to indigenous women in their original language to know her human rights and preventing violence situations.

Macedonia Blas Flores, ñahnö woman and general coordinator of organization was promoted to receive with other 600's mexican women the Peace Nobel Award.
